Allied and Scientific Health Enabling Health Reform

The second round of iCAHE Masterclass will focus on two key themes which reflect the current and emerging requirements for allied and scientific health professionals.

Research into practice and policy: Thursday, 25th of November 2010, will feature presentations and group discussions facilitated by renowned experts on the art and science of integrating research into practice and policy. While the importance of evidence-based practice is widely recognized, implementing evidence into practice and policy continues to pose many challenges. In this workshop allied and scientific health professionals will be exposed to the cutting-edge research on the science of evidence implementation, from a practice and policy perspective, including successful practical examples.

Maximizing your writing: Friday, 26th of November 2010, will feature presentations and workshops facilitated by researchers, academics and policy makers on how to maximise your written word. This Masterclass, which will build on an earlier session (from the first round of Masterclass held in June), will outline how allied and scientific health professionals can maximise their writing in order to achieve the desired outcomes. During this session, specific writing streams will be introduced so that different styles of writing can be explored. For example, writing for publication, writing for policy makers, writing for funding agencies and grant writing are potential writing streams for this Masterclass. Participants are also encouraged to bring their own writing to seek feedback, advice and tips for moving forward.
